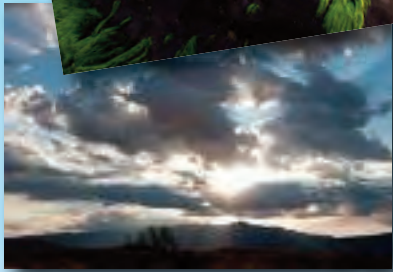
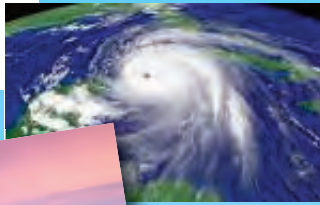




Changing Climate: Changing Weather

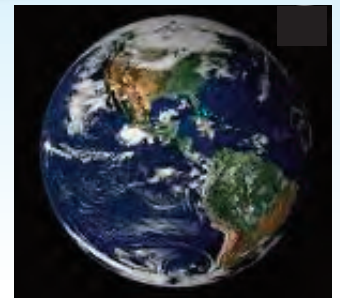

"Changing Climate: Changing Weather" will explore the related, but unique sciences of climate and weather. This hands-on exhibition will demonstrate how changes in our climate cause changes in our weather. Interactive elements will guide visitors through the history of weather and climate change through an in depth-look at the greenhouse effect and our earth's current challenge of global warming. The exhibition will also provide visitors with a greater understanding of what they personally can do to reduce their own "Carbon Footprint" by saving energy, using alternative energy sources and learning to "Reduce, Reuse & Recycle!"
