MUSEUM STATEMENT

The Monmouth Museum is hosting a **JURIED PHOTOGRAPHY INVITATIONAL EXHIBITION** from September 26 - November 2, 2008. This exhibition will feature work that demonstrates the breadth and diversity of expression in contemporary photography.

PROSPECTUS

Eligibility Requirements

- The exhibition is open to any artist 18 years and older.
- All submissions must be original in content, concept, and design.
- All photographs including black and white, color, non-silver, computer manipulated, etc. are eligible.
- All submissions must have been completed within the last five years.

SUBMISSION MATERIALS

Artists may submit a maximum of FOUR works on a CD for consideration.

- Images on the CD must be provided in two formats in two folders:
 - A folder labeled "JPEGs"** should contain images saved as JPEGs at 72 dpi by 900 pixels in the longest dimension for viewing AND
 - A folder labeled "TIFFs"** should contain images saved as TIFF files at 400 dpi by 1800 pixels in the longest dimension for reproduction.
- Label each file with your last name, title and consecutive numbers from 1 - 4. Example for each submission: Smith | Sunflowers.jpeg. and Smith | Sunflowers.tiff.
- Burn all images onto a CD and format for viewing on a PC.
- Label the CD with your name, address, and phone number.
- Please affix your completed entry form inside the CD case.
- The CD must be accompanied by a typed list with the # of the artwork, artist's name, title of work, medium, dimensions, year of completion, price or NFS (not for sale).

Artist Statement

All artists should include a statement on the body of work submitted. Explain your choice of media, subject matter, training, influences, etc. Make sure you reference the work submitted rather than work you have done throughout your career.

Fees

- Submission of work by Monmouth Museum members is free.
- Non-members must pay a non-refundable \$20 fee to submit CD's for consideration.
- A Museum membership application form is included on page 3.
- Please make checks payable to the Monmouth Museum.

Return of materials

If you wish to have your submission materials returned, please include a SASE that is adequate in size for the return of your materials with sufficient postage along with your submission. Materials submitted by artists selected to exhibit may be kept on file with the Museum, and may be used for promotional purposes.

CONDITIONS

- Artists are responsible for all shipping and insurance costs to the Museum and the return shipping and insurance costs.
- Local artists may hand deliver and pick up accepted works during normal Museum hours.
- Entries not accompanied by all completed forms, digital images and fees cannot be juried.
- The Museum reserves the right to reject work delivered at the time of the exhibition that does not represent the artist's accepted work.
- Selected artwork must arrive ready to hang. All photographs must be framed with plexiglass and must have museum-quality hanging wires.
- Delivery and pickup details will be confirmed with the announcement of acceptance.

JURORS

Stephen Perloff is a writer, educator, photographer and editor of *The Photo Review*, a critical journal of national scope and international readership. Published since 1976, *The Photo Review* covers photography events throughout the country and serves as a central resource for the Mid-Atlantic region. Perloff has been interviewed for the *New York Times*, the *Wall Street Journal*, the *Philadelphia Inquirer*, the *BucksCounty Courier Times*, and *Art Matters*. He has received two critic's fellowships from the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts.

Sarah Morthland is the co-founder and owner of Archive Consulting & Management Services LLC in New York City, a firm specializing in appraisals of documentary and fine art photographs and photographic collection management. She is also a private dealer of vintage and contemporary photographs with a broad interest in the medium.

PUBLICITY

The Monmouth Museum provides a printed invitation, e-mail and press release announcements to media and members, and an exhibition opening reception.

SALES

The Monmouth Museum encourages sale of exhibited art work. The Museum will collect the purchase price for all work, take a 20% sales commission and issue a check for the remainder to the artist at the close of the exhibition. If work is sold during the exhibition, a red star will be placed on the label and the purchaser may pick up the work at the end of the exhibition.
