Since reopening June of 2021, the Museum has worked tirelessly to provide quality access to the arts. This summer, we saw about 6,000 visitors. I am so thrilled to announce our newest addition, The Garrett Reisman Center for Air & Space, which will open this Fall exploring the history of human flight & beyond.
